

Our Mission

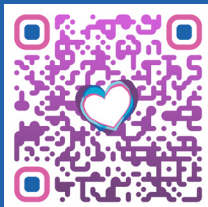

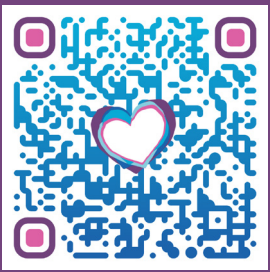

Our Work in the Community

Promote mental health of hospital workers.

We provide health and wellness support and seminars to hospital workers. We also provide professional development and training for nurses at local colleges.

Promote education of future nurses.

We provide scholarships to local nursing students. In the spring of 2023 we gave out one \$1000 and two \$750 scholarships to three local students. We plan to continue (and hopefully increase) our scholarship offerings each year..and training for nurses at local colleges.

Provide support and healing to frontline workers.

We provide meals and treats to local hospital departments and "thank you" cards to hospital staff and volunteers. We randomly surprise workers with gift cards while at the hospital, sparking the flame of giving.

Provide Code Lavender support to patients' families.

We provide blankets, books, lavender sachets, adult coloring books, stress balls, fidget spinners, hand lotion, and other relaxing items to help relieve stress while families deal with their loved ones in intensive care.
